Dear Parents and Caregivers

It has been decided to change the collection arrangements for our **Cash for Cans** Recycling initiative.

Up until now, three large yellow top bins have been available around the school for this purpose. Unfortunately, a lot of rubbish has also ended up in these bins. The **new arrangements, beginning Thursday 29 August [Week 7]** will be as follows:

- 3 Yellow Top Bins, each with a photo of what items can be recycled/put in it, will be placed along the pathway adjacent to the Pick-Up Zone from 7:45am – 9:00am.

Please use this opportunity to either park or use the drive through to unload your recycling into the designated bins.

The following items will be accepted for recycling purposes:

Bin 1: Soft drink bottles and cans [no lids please].

Bin 2: Water bottles [no lids please].

Bin 3: Small flavoured milk cartons or small plastic milk bottles [no large milk plastic bottles or lids please].

Funds raised through this recycling initiative will be earmarked to purchase Agile Furniture for our Library/Resource Centre for all our students to use.

Thank you for your support in this community project as we continue to consider the impact of our carbon footprint.
