### CODE OF CONDUCT Year 2 Excursions 2019

#### Students should:

- 1. Exhibit safe behaviour at all times for example: walking on concrete pathways, keeping hands and feet to themselves, remaining seated when travelling in a vehicle, reporting to parent helpers and remaining with the group, etc.
- 2. Listen to and obey instructions given from, venue staff, St Paul's staff and parent helpers.
- 3. Treat all students and adults with respect.
- 4. Treat animals with respect.
- 5. Follow rules as set out by venue staff and St Paul's staff.
- 6. Care for their and other's belongings.
