Dear Parents and Caregivers of Year 3 Students

We hope that you and your families have enjoyed a good and restful break and are looking forward to the term ahead.

This term, we will be inquiring and investigating into the following:

<u>English</u>: Our main focus is on Daily 5: Read to self, read aloud, listen to someone read, word work and writing. Developing comprehension with inferring in reading will be a significant focus. In writing students will work on information reports relating to our inquiry unit.

<u>Christian Studies</u>: We will be looking at local Christian Churches in our community. We will also explore how other countries around the world celebrate Christmas.

<u>Maths</u>: Maths will be taught using the Daily 3 framework - Developing students' proficiency, understanding, fluency, problem solving and reasoning across all strands of mathematics.

Integrated Studies: During the term, we will continue to explore 'Where do we fit in the world?' within the context of being Australians and inquiring into Asian/ Pacific countries. This leads us into our final inquiry unit relating to celebrations and commemorations in other places in the world.

<u>Home Learning</u>: The primary focus of home learning will be to ensure your child is reading every night.
