## Classroom Teachers: Mr John Smith and Mrs Marnie Ferguson Teacher Assistants / Learning Support: Mrs Emma Chapman, Carissa Klinge and Linda Larkin

This term, we will be inquiring and investigating into the following:

<u>English</u>: Our big focus is on Daily 5: Read to self, read aloud, listen to someone read, word work and writing. Developing expression and comprehension in reading will be a significant focus. In writing, students will work on the narrative and persuasive genres relating to our inquiry unit. Students will concentrate on recognising and using parts of speech to develop interesting sentence structure as well as writing for a particular audience.

Christian Studies: Students will investigate how God motivates us to serve and help others.

<u>Maths</u>: Maths will be taught using the Daily 3 framework - Developing students' proficiency, understanding, fluency, problem solving and reasoning across all strands of mathematics.

<u>Integrated Studies</u>: Students will be investigating how to keep themselves safe. Later during the term, they will further explore "Spinning in Space" supported by the incursion with Dr Joe.

<u>Home Learning</u>: The primary focus of home learning will be to ensure your child is reading every night. Further details regarding home learning will be discussed at the Parent Information Evening.
