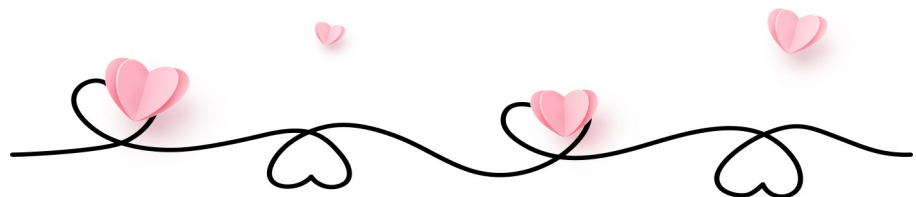

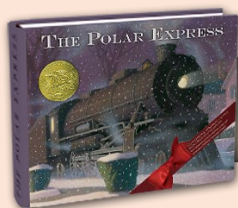

DOES YOUR CHILD LOVE TO ACT?

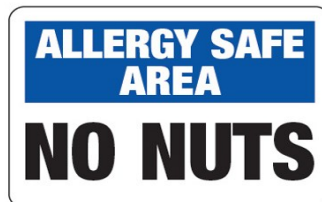
We have a new drama club commencing in Term 4 Week 1 for Year 4, 5 & 6.
