Dear Parents and Caregivers of Prep – Year 6 Students

We hope that you have had a relaxing Winter break as a family. As we begin to prepare for the return of students and parents on Tuesday 14 July, we would like to bring the following updates, arrangements and reminders to your attention:

- Due to the fact that parents and caregivers are still not permitted on our school campus, **the morning Drop-Off and afternoon Pick-Up arrangements** will remain the same as per the last 5 weeks of Term 2. All students are again asked to enter and exit the school, unless arranged otherwise, via the Drop-Off and Pick-Up zone. **Please remember children are to get in or out of the car from the left-hand passenger side doors only and drivers should remain in their vehicles at all times in the Drop-Off and Pick-Up Zone.** If your child requires assistance getting in and out of the vehicle, you are asked to park, assist them and walk them across to the gate.
- As per last term, **any early student departures need to be done via the front office.** A student needing to depart early, will be called to the office and depart with their parent/caregiver. Please remember to adhere to the social distancing requirements and markings on display when visiting the front office.
- Please remember that all **tuckshop and uniform orders need to be made via Flexischools**, with orders delivered to your child's classroom on the day.
- Unfortunately, parents will be unable to attend Assemblies and Chapels. We will however arrange for the Week 2 Assembly where students will receive Semester 1 Effort Awards to be made available via a live stream (details to be confirmed).
- **Please remember not to send your child to school if they are unwell, as families will be contacted to come and collect unwell children.**
- Please remember that **Monday 13 July is a Pupil Free Day**, as staff will be undertaking First Aid Training.

We remain committed to continue providing the best hygiene requirements and practices for all the students and staff in the coming term. We are also looking forward to a time when we can welcome you back to being part of every day school life at St Paul's.
