Dear Parents and Caregivers of Year 2 Students

Welcome back to a jam packed Term 3 in Year 2. We hope that you had a lovely winter break and enjoyed the Queensland winter sun.

In English this term, the children will be involved in an explorative author study of Julia Donaldson. This will have the children delving into her stories and inquiring into a narrative structure and using this knowledge to write their own narrative. Students will publish their narrative using a form of media.

In Maths, we will continue to focus on understanding 3-digit numbers as well as exploring many areas such as length, time, fractions and collecting data.

This term the students go back in time investigating what it was like to live in the past, experimenting with forces in Science and the application of them today. Students will also be involved in a design process and will interpret art works.

In Christian Studies, students will be focusing on the Parables that Jesus taught. They will be learning to understand how these stories apply to life today.

HOME LEARNING

The new home learning will continue on Seesaw via a Seesaw activity from Week 2. A new activity will be sent out each week.
