Dear Parents and Caregivers of Year 5 Students

Welcome back and here we go for Term 4 in the 2020 school year, the home stretch. We hope that you and your families have enjoyed a lovely restful break and are looking forward to the term ahead as much as we are. Mr Nicholls is happy to be back in the Year 5 Agile learning lab teaching again with Mrs Farrell.

This term we will be inquiring and investigating into the following:

<u>English</u>: Our writing unit will focus on biographies. Our Daily 5 activities such as read to self, read aloud, word work and writing continues to support the development of students' reading fluency and comprehension.

<u>Christian Studies:</u> In this unit, the students will investigate the themes of Service, Love and Discipleship through an examination of how Jesus lived his life and the lessons that Jesus taught. The students will examine and begin their own leadership journey within the school and community.

<u>Health:</u> Our continuing themed unit Youniqueness, covers the topics of health as we explore our changing bodies and the impact on social and emotional wellbeing.

<u>Science:</u> We will continue and wrap up our exciting topic of Earth's Place in Space through the term, which will include some artwork, digital presentations and our own human scale Solar System.

<u>Maths:</u> Daily 3 - Developing students' proficiency, understanding, fluency and problem solving and reasoning across all strands of mathematics using various resources such as iMaths, Think Mentals, Seesaw, etc. will continue. We will be participating in a few interesting investigations such as 'My Restaurant Rules' which will involve creating our own menus and role playing a restaurant experience.

<u>Home Learning:</u> Home learning is optional. However, we strongly urge the primary focus be to ensure your child is reading every night.
