

# **INSIDE STORY: YEAR 5**

In Mathematics in Year 5 this term, we have been looking at transformations of shapes and lines of symmetry. We made tile designs that demonstrated our understanding of how two-dimensional shapes can change their position through flips (reflections), slides (translations) and turns (rotations), and we identified line and rotational symmetry in our patterns.

We are now looking at fractions, and here we estimated how much paper we had cut away when making snowflakes. Can you find the snowflakes that we estimated have had half, a third or a quarter removed?
