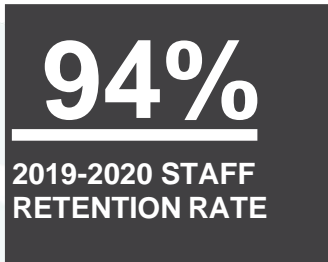
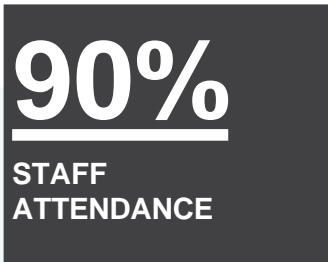
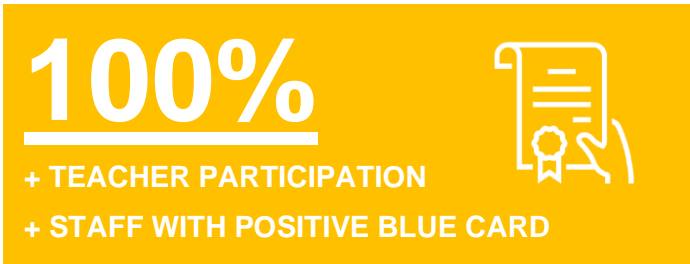
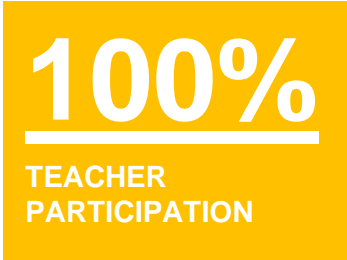


### OVERALL STUDENT SATISFACTION\*
