Sports Gala Day Competition Information

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Caboolture district Gala Day Sports are set to go ahead, weather permitting.

DATES: Term 1, Week 6 - Friday 18 March & Term 2, Week 3 - Friday 6 May 2022.

SPORTS: We will field teams in Netball (Girls), Soccer (Boys), Rugby League (Boys).

VENUES: TBC (depending upon flood restoration) however scheduled for;

- Apex Park – Netball;
- Moreton Bay Fields – Soccer; and
- Petersen Rd Complex - Rugby League.

COST: All costs are being funded by St Paul's Lutheran Primary School.

COMPETITION: Draw and times of the daily matches are yet to be confirmed.

TRANSPORT: Buses have been booked to take students to and from the grounds. Students are asked to arrive at school by 8:30am normal time, buses depart school at 8:45am, returning to school by 3:00pm. Students who catch the bus home from school on Friday's, are asked to make other transportation arrangements home on these days. If Private transport is preferred to and or from the venue, please inform Mr Wooding via email – bwooding@stpaulslps.qld.edu.au.

CLOTHING: St Paul's representative jerseys will be provided to wear on competition days; school hat and correct uniform sports shoes (white) to be worn to school. Suitable playing shoes (e.g. boots) can be brought to change in to at the venue & shin pads must be worn. Mouth guards are compulsory for Rugby League. St Paul's football socks can be purchased from the uniform shop. Sunscreen must be used.

FOOD: Students are asked to bring their own morning tea and lunch, sufficient for the whole day. Children are to bring their own full, labelled water bottle.
