Congratulations, your child has qualified to represent St Paul's at the upcoming Caboolture District Cross Country Trials for 2022.

DATES: Term 2, Week 3, Tuesday 3rd May 2022

VENUE: Burpengary Sports Complex - Station Road, Burpengary

TRANSPORT: Students are asked to **arrive at St Paul's by 8:30am**, **departing by bus at 8:45am**. The St Paul's team will be transported by a bus provided by St Paul's to and from the venue. Students will be **returning to school by 2:15pm**, for afternoon lessons as normal. Private transport is also an option, should this suit your family. CLOTHING: Students are to wear the St Paul's Representative singlet when competing (made available on the day of the event), school shirt to be worn over singlet when not competing, school sport shorts, school hat, tracksuit (if needed) and appropriate running shoes (NO metal spikes). A change of shoes and socks is suggested due to the probability of damp grass.

FOOD AND OTHER ITEMS: Please ensure your child brings a sufficient amount of water, morning tea, lunch and sun screen.

PARENTS/SPECTATORS & COVID PLAN: Parents/spectators are welcome and encouraged to attend the event, remembering and adhering to all relevant and appropriate COVID mitigation procedures.

Students who finish in the top five placings for their age group will be invited to represent Caboolture District at the regional Trials, to be held at Maroochydore Cricket Club, Buderim, on Tuesday 31st May, 2022. These children will receive more information on the day of District Cross Country.

It is also a new requirement that students attending regional trials must have had an opportunity to complete a Queensland School Sport Project Consent Form (PCF). Therefore, to fast track this process, please also read and complete the attached 3 paged (back-to-back copied) document. This is a directive from Legal Branch. Please return ALL forms to the School Office by Thursday 28th April 2022.

Permission and medical details must be completed on Parent Lounge by Thursday 28th April 2022.
