Re: Sports Gala Day Competition and Alternate Program Information

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Caboolture district Gala Day Sports are set to go ahead weather permitting. For those Year 4-6 students who are **NOT** involved, will be offered a choice of alternate activities run by teaching staff including Art and Robotics.

<u>ALTERNATE PROGRAMS</u> are a new addition at St Paul's to offer optional curriculum in an area other than competitive sport. Students will be asked to select their alternative program in class prior to the day. This is considered a normal school day and attendance is expected. **No parent lounge permission is required for this option.**

DATES: Week 3, Friday 6 May & Week 4, Friday 13 May, 2022.

SPORTS: Netball (Girls) and Soccer (Boys).

VENUES: Apex Park, Caboolture (Netball) and Bribie Island Soccer Fields (Soccer).

COST: All costs are being funded by St Paul's Lutheran Primary School.

COMPETITION: Draw and times of the daily matches are yet to be confirmed, however playing time is between 10am and 2pm (individual teams may start later or finish earlier than indicated).

TRANSPORT: Buses have been booked to take students to and from the grounds. Students are asked to arrive at school by 8:30am normal time, buses depart school at 8:45am, returning to school by 2:45pm. <u>CLOTHING:</u> St Paul's representative jerseys will be provided to wear on competition days for soccer and rugby league teams; school hat and correct uniform sports shoes (white) to be worn to school. Suitable playing shoes (e.g. football boots) can be brought to change in to at the venue & shin pads must be worn for soccer. Sunscreen must be used.

<u>FOOD:</u> Students are asked to bring their own morning tea, and lunch plus snacks, sufficient for the whole day. Children are to bring their own full, labelled water bottle. Venue canteens are not to be accessed by the students from St Paul's.

<u>PARENT HELPERS:</u> If any parents and/or caregivers are attending and able to assist the teams (e.g. possibly umpiring or assist supervising) on either Gala Days, it would be greatly appreciated.
