- ❖ Sessions to be held Tuesdays and Wednesdays 3.05 4:05pm on the school hardcourt.
- ❖ 2 female coaches American professionals playing NBL1 as "imported players".
- ❖ Year 4/5/6 Sessions Tuesdays 24th May, 31st May, 7th June, 14th June
- ❖ Year 2/3/4 Sessions Wednesdays 25th May, 1st June, 8th June, 15th June
- Boys and girls are welcome.
- Sports shoes, school sports uniform
- Parents are welcome to observe part or all of the session but must be present at 4.00pm to collect children.
- ❖ Mr Wooding will take a roll at 3:00pm & 4:05pm to confirm attendance and safe departure from the undercover area in front of the tuckshop.
