Bell Times

We would prefer our students to arrive at 8:25am ready for an 8:30am start. School finishes at 3:00pm. Please continue to check for updates from the school regarding pick up and drop off and visiting the school campus procedures.

Chapel and Assembly Time

Whole school Chapel will be held on Wednesday mornings at 8:35am and Assembly will begin at 8:35am on every second Friday. Please feel free to come along to these weekly events (dependent on Government COVID – 19 guidelines).

Library

Mrs Stephens will be our Teacher Librarian in the GLAD centre this year. It will be open from 8am to 3.30pm Monday to Thursday. When COVID restrictions are relaxed, parents may visit the GLAD Centre in the morning from 8am or after school with their child until 3.30pm. All students have a



weekly library lesson which supports inquiry learning and reading engagement. Lessons will include book promotions, literary events, learning research skills and story times. Students will borrow library books during this lesson.

Japanese

All students participate in weekly Japanese lessons with Poetschka Sensei. Learning a language provides students with an excellent opportunity to broaden their view of the world, develop a respect for other cultures, and appreciate their ideas and ways of thinking.

At St Paul's, we encourage students to practice and share their vocabulary and Hiragana at home with their families.

Music

Classroom Music is taught weekly by Ms Carol Ellwood. Through active participation – singing, moving, creating and playing - students continue to develop musical independence. In Year 3, students learn more about improvisation, graphic scores and program music.

All Year 3 students participate in a String Immersion Program to extend musical learning, providing a link between classroom and instrumental music. In 2022, students may choose to play one of the following six instruments: Violin, Viola, Cello, Double Bass, Guitar, or Ukulele. Taking place during the school day, students attend one 30-minute session each week with specialist music tutors. Immersion fees are \$65 per term (included in your annual school fees). This fee includes the provision of an instrument and resources for the year, weekly group tuition and performance opportunities.

Physical Education (P.E.)

Students participate in a weekly 45 minute session with Mr Brad Wooding (Terms 1-3) and Mrs Jessica Schnieder. Other sports carnivals, gala days and events will occur throughout the year. Please keep an eye on the calendar and announcements for confirmation of these dates.

Home Learning

Students are required to do 15 minutes of reading every day at home. Further information will be provided in our Parent Information Presentation.

Crunch and Sip
