Dear Parents and Carers,

We are excited to offer the String Immersion Program to Year 3 students this year, as part of Arts @ St Paul's.

PROGRAM

This program offers:

- a choice of six instruments to extend students' music learning in violin, viola, cello, double bass, guitar or ukulele
- the provision of an instrument and accessories
- the provision of a tuition book (hard copy) and/or digital resources (via Seesaw)
- weekly group tuition and beginner performance ensembles, held during the school day with specialised performing arts tutors
- opportunities to perform at Twilight Music Recitals and school events throughout the year
- alignment with learning in the classroom music program

FEES

An Immersion Fee of \$65 per term is added to school fees.
