This term, we will be inquiring and investigating into the following:

English: As we prepare for NAPLAN, we will consolidate our narrative and creative practise and focus further on persuasive writing. We will continue to use Charlie & the Chocolate Factory as our text. NAPLAN is scheduled for Weeks 4 and 5 of Term 2.

<u>Christian Studies</u>: We will be analysing rescue stories from the Bible while looking at Sin and Forgiveness.

<u>Maths</u>: Maths will continue with our Number Talks sessions to start us off and explore focus concepts of time, maps and grid referencing, addition and subtraction with money.

<u>Integrated Studies</u>: During the term, students will further explore our first Inquiry Unit, "Spinning in Space".

<u>Home Learning</u>: The primary focus of Home Learning will be to ensure your child is reading every night.
